EC Polymer Notes: Cleaner... Safer... Stronger

FEEL



Polymer feels smoother than the material from which the paper banknotes are made.



The front of each note has raised bumps at the top left-hand corner. The bumps form familiar shapes.

LOOK



There is a clear window at the front and back of notes which allows you to see through the notes.



If you hold the notes up to the light, you will see the note value hidden in an area of plain coloured print.

TILT





A holographic foil is on the \$100, \$50 and \$20. The images move and their colours change when you tilt the notes.





















Counterfeit EC notes do not have any value. Remember, it is a criminal offence to be in possession or pass on counterfeit EC Notes.

If you think you are in possession of counterfeit EC notes, take them to the nearest police station or ECCB Headquarters/Agency Office.
