Support for Farmers PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION UNIT (PIU)

The **Government of Dominica** has received funding from the **World Bank** for the **"Dominica Emergency Agricultural Livelihoods and Climate Resilience Project (DEALCRP)"** to be implemented in a five-year period.

It is designed to help crop farmers affected by Hurricane Maria restore their agriculture livelihoods, and adopt climate resilience practices, through provision of:

- An essential package of inputs (mainly improved quality seeds and fertilizers), tools, and materials for the replanting or restoration of crops.
- Technical advisory services and training.

The project supports three categories of farmers with the following:

- 1. Small Size: Open field ¼ acre to 2 acres Irrigated - more than ¼ acre to ½ acre Greenhouse - more than (30 ft. x 60 ft.) /1800 sq. ft.
- 2. **Medium Size**: Open field more than 2 acres and less than 5 acres Irrigation more than ½ acre and less than 1 acre
  Green house (30 ft. x 60 ft.) or more than 3600 sq. ft. and less than 5400 sq. ft.
- **3. Large Size:** Open field more than 5 acres. (maximum 8 acres) Irrigation more than 1 acre
  Green house Three (30 ft. x 60 ft.) or more than 5400 sq. ft.
- Medium farmers must match 30% of the project contribution and large farmers must match 50%.
- Two and three greenhouses project matches 75%

Beneficiaries crop farmers will chose a package from the **FIVE main cropping** systems in Dominica, namely: (**Vegetables, Banana/Plantain, Root Crops, Horticulture and Tree Crops).** 

Under the project farmers will receive seeds, organic fertilizer, organic agricultural inputs, tools, and motorized equipment, in portions of their cultivated acreage.

#### **Vegetable** package beneficiaries will receive

- 10% Seeds certified seeds
- 20% Organic Fertilizer
- 20% Organic Agricultural inputs nematicides, insecticides, fungicides and
- 50% Tools and Equipment

#### Banana/Plantain package beneficiaries will receive

- 25% Fertilizer
- 25% Agricultural inputs nematicide, bunch protection (diothene and guying chord
- 50% Tools and Equipment

## **Root Crops** package beneficiaries will receive

- 25% Fertilizer
- 25% Agricultural inputs
- 50% Tools and Equipment

### **Horticulture** package beneficiaries will receive

- 10% Seedlings /inviro propagated plants
- 20% Fertilizer
- 20% Agricultural inputs
- 50% Tools and Equipment

# **Tree Crops** package beneficiaries will receive

- 25% Fertilizer
- 25% Agricultural inputs
- 50% Tools and Equipment

# All five categories cropping system will receive package benefit of 50% tools and equipment to include:

Forks, drain spades, desukering tools, cutlass, knives, files, draining tools, trays, tubs, ladders; hoes, rakes, secateurs, drain shovels, jack spades, harvesting crates,55 gallon drums, seedling trays, wheel barrows, water pump,1000 gal water tank, passion fruit wire, drip irrigation line, shade netting, potting pots,(PPEs goggles, gloves, respirators), brush cutters, soil augers, mist blowers, knapsack sprayers, small mist blowers, motorized knapsack, rotavatos, pruning saws, chain saws, power tillers, and wood shedders.
